Using A-PDF Screen Tutorial Maker

A-PDF Screen Tutorial Maker can be started either by launching the application via the desktop short



Start the program, you will see the below initial window:



You can complete tutorial building work just with below steps.

1. Add Step

You can add image in 3 different ways: Select Screen, Select Window or Import Image:



(1) Select Screen

When you choose "Select Screen", you can draw a select box on the screen to extract information on any area of the screen, and there are tips in the below window:



Then click "Correct" icon to complete capturing work, the captured screen will be shown in the Image list.

(2) Select Window

You can directly select opened window to be added to the image list:




Just click the icon to choose the whole window on your screen.

(3) Import Image

You can add existing image from your computer directly for building tutorial.

2. Edit Page



In Page editing panel, you can define page title, page text/description, edit image with multiple tools, etc.

You can also define text font, font size, align, color, fill color, fill type and so on. After editing, you can copy, paste, delete, clear or replace current image just by right-clicking.

There is a special tool for you to use—spelling check:




3. Publish

After editing pages, you can publish as your wanted format. A-PDF Screen Tutorial Maker provides you 5 different publish formats:



(1). Export To PDF

Choose "Export to PDF" option to output your tutorial as PDF format. You can define PDF Header and Foot, Properties, Style, Align, Frame, Page title and description text font, size, color:




(2). Export to Html

You can also export edited pages as HTML format for easy viewing online:



(3). Export to Word

Export tutorial into DOC, you can define Image frame, font, shadow, quality, hearer and footer:





(4). Send by Email

You can even send your created tutorial file to others via Email instantly. The output tutorial format is PDF, so the output options could be the same as "Export to PDF". Instead of forming a PDF tutorial in your computer, it will add outputted PDF file as an attachment to your current Email server.

(5). Export to Image

Directly output your tutorial as JPG images, you can choose folder, name, range to export.



4. Save Project

If you want to save current images, edited text or page settings as a project file for easy loading later, you can click icon "Save Project" or "Save Project As".

Then when you want to reuse the project you stored before, just click icon to load project directly.
