About A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split

A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split is a simple, lightning-fast desktop utility program that lets you merge single or multi-page TIFF files into one single multi-page TIFF file or split multipage TIFF files into many single page TIFF files with efficiency and reliability. Besides, the tool can split and convert TIFF to JPEG, BMP, GIF, and PNG.

Features of the TIFF Merger and Split Include:

- Merge or Split TIFF files exceptionally fast!
- Drag and drop files to be merged or splitted
- Split TIFF and convert to TIFF, BMP, GIF, JPG and PNG.
- Define splitted TIFF Name Marco

System Requirement

- Win98/ME/NT/2000/XP/Win7/Vista platforms;
- Acrobat Reader 5.0 or above.

Using A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split

A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split can be started either by launching the application via a desktop shortcut, or directly from within Windows/Windows Explorer.




Using A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split

When you start the program, you will be presented with the primary screen from which all actions are taken.



Selecting Tiff File

Clicking the **Add Tiff Image** icon , or selecting **File** then choosing **Add Tiff Image** will open the standard file browse and select window. From that window you can navigate to the folder and find the files you want to add to the list of files to be merged or splitted from.

Alternatively, if you are using Windows Explorer to locate files, you have the convenience of being able to 'drag and drop' files into the document window.

A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split even allows you to select all files in a particular directory/folder by using the **Add a Directory** option from the **File** menu! Add a directory also supports sub-folders.

Each added file is displayed in the TIFF Merge and Split Left-Top window, as seen in the example below. You can view any of the files in the window by 'double-clicking' them. That will open pdf files in your default pdf reader program (usually Adobe Reader).

Merge Tiff Files

Click the **Merge All** windows.

Split Tiff Files

Click the Split All



icon to Split All of tiff files in the Tiff list windows.

Split Option


A-PDF TIFF Merge and Split allow you to define the tiff splitted single page name or splitted image format; you can set output option by click the setting button icon.
